The Statewide Transit Training and Technical Assistance Program located at the Center for Urban Transportation Research (CUTR) at the University of South Florida and the Florida Department of Transportation will be presenting the **Substance Abuse Management Regulatory Compliance Training Course** from 8:00 a.m.—12:00 p.m. and the **Reasonable Suspicion for Transit Supervisors** from 1:00 pm—5:00 pm on **December 2, 2008 in South Daytona, Florida.**

SUBSTANCE ABUSE REGULATORY COMPLIANCE TRAINING COURSE

The Department of Transportation recently amended certain provisions of its drug and alcohol testing procedures (49 CFR Part 40). This training course is being offered to provide transit properties with specific details of the new amendment revisions and how these changes will affect them.

Participants will be introduced to a new FDOT model policy template that will incorporate the new amendment revisions. This course will also offer participants an opportunity to discuss best practices that meet or exceed regulatory compliance in all areas of drug and alcohol testing programs. Upon completion, each attendee will receive a certificate of completion from the Statewide Transit Training and Technical Assistance Program at Center for Urban Transportation Research at the University of South Florida.

REASONABLE SUSPICION FOR TRANSIT SUPERVISORS

This course will train designated transit personnel in identifying probable signs and symptoms of prohibited drug use and probable signs and symptoms of alcohol misuse by covered employees performing safety-sensitive job functions. Participants will also be given the tools and skills necessary for conducting reasonable suspicion interviews and testing referrals. Role play exercises and activities will be included in order to create an interactive classroom experience. This course will exceed the FTA supervisory training requirement (49 CFR Part 655.14); each participant will receive a certificate of successful completion.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Transit agency substance abuse program managers, human resource managers, safety managers, state DOT representatives, and third-party contractors for transit substance abuse programs. Road supervisors, maintenance supervisors, drug and alcohol program managers, safety managers, any transit personnel with frequent interaction with safety sensitive employees.

Funding for this course is provided by the Florida Department of Transportation through the Statewide Transit Training and Technical Assistance Program.
