



PREVENTION AND RESPONSE TO SUICIDE BOMBING INCIDENTS (PRsBI) INCIDENT RESPONSE TO BOMBINGS (IRTB)

FEBRUARY 17, 2009 TAMPA, FLORIDA

The Florida Statewide Transit Training and Technical Assistance Program located at the Center for Urban Transportation Research (CUTR) at the University of South Florida and sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation will be hosting two Department of Homeland Security certified courses from the EMRTC/New Mexico Tech.

The DHS training sessions entitled “**Prevention and Response to Suicide Bombing Incidents (PRsBI)**” and “**Incident Response to Bombings (IRTB)**” will be presented on February 17, 2009 in Tampa, Florida.

The four hour performance level **PRsBI** course provides senior state and local emergency responders with the knowledge and skills needed to develop policies for the prevention, interdiction, response, and mitigation of a suicide bombing attack. It also provides basic information on explosive and incendiary devices that could be used as terrorist weapons. The four hour performance level **IRTB** course provides basic information on explosive and incendiary devices that could be used as terrorist weapons and is designed for first responders who may respond to incidents involving explosives.

Classroom topics include:

- Understanding the terrorist threat
- Improvised explosive devices (IEDs)
- Safety issues
- Departmental or agency policies to ensure compliance with local requirements

SCOPE of SERVICES

The Scope of the Courses will involve The Terrorist Threat, Introduction to Explosives, Incident Scene Operations, Evidence and Forensics in Bomb, Air Blast and Post-Blast Pathology, Improvised Explosive Devices, Pipe Bombs, and Letter Bombs, Fertilizer-Based Improvised Explosives, Improvised Explosives, Initiation Systems for Explosive Materials, Military and Commercial Explosives, Practical Exercises, Case Study, Air Blast Effects on Structures, and Suicide Bombings.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Florida’s Law Enforcement, Fire, EMS, HL Security officials, Safety & Security officials, Military, Coast Guard and Florida’s transit agency and transportation personnel.
