Scholar Commons is an online research repository that stores completed works and data sets for long-term preservation and world-wide electronic accessibility. It is part of the Digital Commons Network™ that includes more than 3.4 million original scholarly works. Search engine optimization throughout the platform means publications are easily found through a web search. Each publication has its own “homepage” with customizable fields and digital object identifier (DOI).

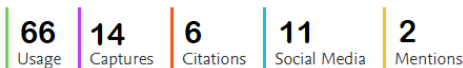

NATIONAL INSTITUTE FOR CONGESTION REDUCTION (NICR) + SCHOLAR COMMONS

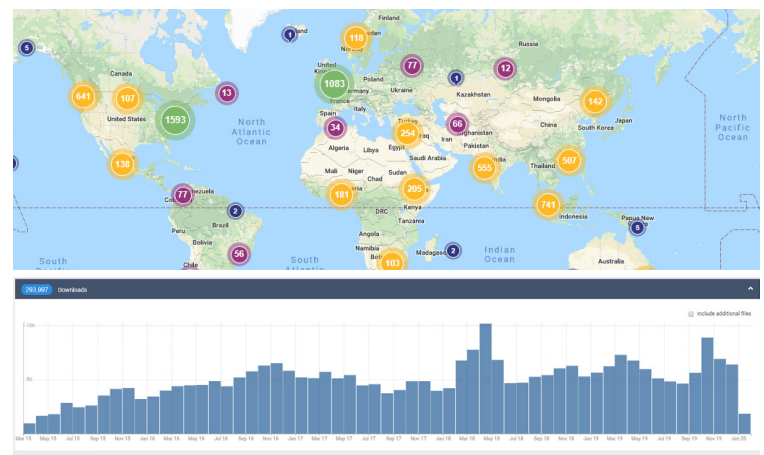
CUTR will use the Scholar Commons platform as a permanent repository for all NICR products, including: reports, policy briefs, U.S. DOT reporting and data sets.

Rather than relying on a possibly damaged website URL, a permanent DOI will be assigned to each asset allowing the asset to have a persistent URL for analytical tracking.
